I would like to take this time to remind everyone that tomorrow, Friday, January 15, is Black Shirt Day. Black Shirt Day is in recognition of the struggle for human and civil rights for Black and racialized Canadians. Black Shirt Day falls on the same day as the birthday of civil rights leader Martin Luther King Jr. Let's show our support by wearing a black shirt tomorrow.

The week of January 25-29 will be the last week of Quarter 2. During this week, students will have the opportunity to complete the provincial Literacy and Numeracy Assessments. Students that are graduating this year, only need to have completed the Numeracy Assessment.
